## Trump targets New Mexico as conservation legislation is signed into law

## From CONSERVATION VOTERS NEW MEXICO

On Tuesday, April 8th, 2025, the Trump Administration took aim at New Mexico. It did so with an executive order instructing the US Attorney General to target state and local laws focused on climate change and environmental, social, and governance initiatives and signaling that no states, local environment, or democratic protection are safe. Make no mistake: Trump's action is unconstitutional. It is also not the first time his Administration has tried to strong-arm state decision-makers and unravel landmark progress on climate.

This news comes on the coattails of New Mexico's historic legislative session, where 16 out of the 21 climate, conservation, and democracy bills that passed have been signed into law and over 400 million in funding was secured for climate and conservation action in the budget and capital outlay bills. We have a lot to be proud of, such as the enormous successes in SB 21 - Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Act and SB 23 - Oil & Gas Royalty Rates and more.
